Several years in the making, the Ben Bernie project represents the most comprehensive and collection of Ben Bernie material ever assembled. Ben Bernie's career spans over 24 years all of which is represented here for the first time by ToNY.

Included in the track list below are all of the Brunswick's and all but one of the Vocalion commercial recordings. A representative series of radio shows are included here as well as some extremely rare Brunswick Brevities from the collection of John Newton. The rare Fox Movietone soundtrack for the lost 1928 film short is represented here provided by Ron Hutchinson.

This definitive Ben Bernie collection of nearly 400 recordings is housed across 20 compact discs and includes one DVD of rare Ben Bernie videos. There were many record collecting contributors to make this project possible. One of the most esteemed being John R.T. Davies, who just before his passing in 2004, made some 27 German non-vocals Brunswick available for ToNY member Jim Baldwin.

Indeed, a fine tribute to the Ol' Maestro and his wonderful orchestras.
